

Mental Health Urgent Care (EISS)

The EISS (Early Intervention Support Services) program uses a holistic approach to mental healthcare. Staffed by a multi-disciplinary team, EISS is co-located with the agency's Psychiatric Emergency Screening Services and other acute care programs in an easily accessible care continuum. EISS maintains close ties with area emergency departments, police, mental health agencies, social service organizations and consumer agencies.

OUR SERVICE OBJECTIVES:

- Ensure consumers who are in crisis have access to appropriate psychiatric care 24/7.
- Assessments, including an assessment of need for psychotropic medication, will be performed by a clinician and an APN upon admission to the program.
- Provide interventions and a range of services and linkages immediately, with referral to long term treatment and support.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Consumers experiencing an emotional, behavioral, situational, or psychiatric event that requires more treatment than standard outpatient consumer care, but does not require PESS.
